## **RICK DAVIS ANNOUNCES CANDIDACY FOR STATE REPRESENTATIVE, DISTRICT 14**

[BRYAN, TEXAS]— ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2009, BRYAN LAWYER AND SOLO PRACTITIONER, RICK DAVIS, ANNOUNCED HIS CANDIDACY FOR THE TEXAS HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, DISTRICT 14. DAVIS FORMERLY SERVED AS JUDGE, 272<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT COURT FOR OVER SEVEN YEARS AND, PRIOR TO THAT, SERVED AS JUDGE, BRAZOS COUNTY COURT AT LAW NO. 2. THE ANNOUNCEMENT CAME AT THE END OF THE BRAZOS VALLEY REPUBLICAN WOMEN'S LUNCHEON WHERE HIS MOTHER-IN-LAW, HIS WIFE, OTHER SUPPORTERS AND HE WERE IN ATTENDANCE.

DAVIS STATES, "Ever since I was a Cadet at Texas A&M, I have sensed a call to public service. It was a privilege to serve the citizens of this community as Judge. Now, I am asking to serve as their representative in the State Legislature. If elected, I will work hard for the citizens of District 14 and to advance the interests of my beloved Texas A&M University.

DAVIS IS MARRIED WITH SIX CHILDREN. HIS OLDEST SON IS A MECHANICAL ENGINEERING MAJOR FINISHING UP HIS FIFTH YEAR AT TEXAS A&M AT QATAR, HIS SECOND SON IS AN ARCHITECTURE MAJOR AND A SOPHOMORE IN THE TEXAS AGGIE CORPS OF CADETS, AND HIS THIRD SON IS A FRESHMAN AT WAYLAN BAPTIST UNIVERSITY. THE YOUNGER THREE CHILDREN ARE STILL IN SCHOOL AT HOME.

AT THE LUNCHEON, DAVIS TOUTED HIS LONG AFFILIATION WITH THE REPUBLICAN PARTY, AND SAID HE WAS A DELEGATE TO THE REPUBLICAN STATE CONVENTION AS FAR BACK AS 1988. INCUMBENT FRED BROWN HAS NOT

ANNOUNCED HIS INTENTIONS AS TO WHETHER HE WILL SEEK RE-ELECTION. FORMER TAX COLLECTOR AND LONG TIME DEMOCRAT BUDDY WINN ANNOUNCED HIS CANDIDACY EARLIER THIS MONTH FOR THE DISTRICT 14 SPOT. WINN SWITCHED HIS AFFILIATION TO THE REPUBLICAN PARTY A FEW YEARS AGO.

DAVIS SAID THAT HE WILL TAKE A STRONG STAND FOR FAMILY VALUES, WILL WORK TO ADVANCE THE INTERESTS OF TEXAS A&M, AND WILL SUPPORT CONSERVATIVE LEGISLATION. HE ALSO PLEDGED TO WORK HARD FOR HIS CONSTITUENTS AND SAID HE WILL KEEP THEM INFORMED.
